A Note to New Readers

The Complete Obama Timeline is updated every night. All new text is highlighted in yellow to make it easy for the reader to spot the additions. The *Timeline* exceeds 10,000 pages* and contain more than 69,000 online references*. At the end of each paragraph the references are listed in brackets. Example:

DailyCaller.com reports that Obama attended the 1991 wedding of Martha Raddatz and Julius Genachowski. Raddatz will moderate the October 11 debate between Joe Biden and Paul Ryan. Genachowski, a former Harvard classmate of Obama, was appointed by him to head the Federal Communications Commission. "Both Politico and The Daily Beast jumped to ABC and Raddatz's defense. The Huffington Post, a liberal news outlet, joined them shortly thereafter, while calling 'unusual' ABC's attempt to kill the story before it gained wide circulation." Raddatz and Genachowski divorced in 1997. Nevertheless, her leftist politics and connections to Obama should make debate viewers wonder whether Raddatz can be impartial. (According to Newsbusters.org, Raddatz is now married to Tom Gjelten, a veteran National Public Radio journalist—who no doubt does not want his taxpayer-funded paychecks to stop. Along with Genachowski, another ex-husband of Raddatz is Ben Bradlee III, son of the former executive editor of *The Washington Post*. In other words, she has liberal credentials. The reference numbers [38236, etc.] can then be found by clicking that numbered item in the reference files. (Click the references item in the left side bar to access those files.)

The paperbacks use the same reference system, with numbers in brackets [12345]. Each paperback also has an extensive index.

Some of the links, of course, disappear over time, and the "Obots" have done their best to delete some of the more damaging items from the Internet. The *Timeline* often lists more than one source for the information in each paragraph so that if one link stops working you can find another. Both conservative and liberal sources are included; you will find information from the Huffington Post, *The New York Times*, Politico, etc., as well as HotAir.com, DailyCaller.com, *Newsmax*, *The Wall Street Journal*, etc.

The *Timeline* also includes Obama-related rumors that may or may not someday be proven accurate. *National Enquirer*-type nonsense ("Proof that Obama was born on Mars!") is not included, but the *Timeline* does not shy away from reporting speculation about Obama's place of birth, the identity of his father, or any suggestions of impropriety

or illegality. We may never know the *full* story, but all speculation that may have some reasonable merit is included in the *Timeline*.

I have attempted to provide as much information about Obama as possible—much of which one would *never* learn from watching the mainstream media's evening news broadcasts. I leave it to the reader to make his or her own judgment of Obama based on that information. Yes, I receive more than a fair amount of insulting emails and even death threats. So be it. No one is obligated to agree with me. I am merely presenting the facts I have been able to assemble.
