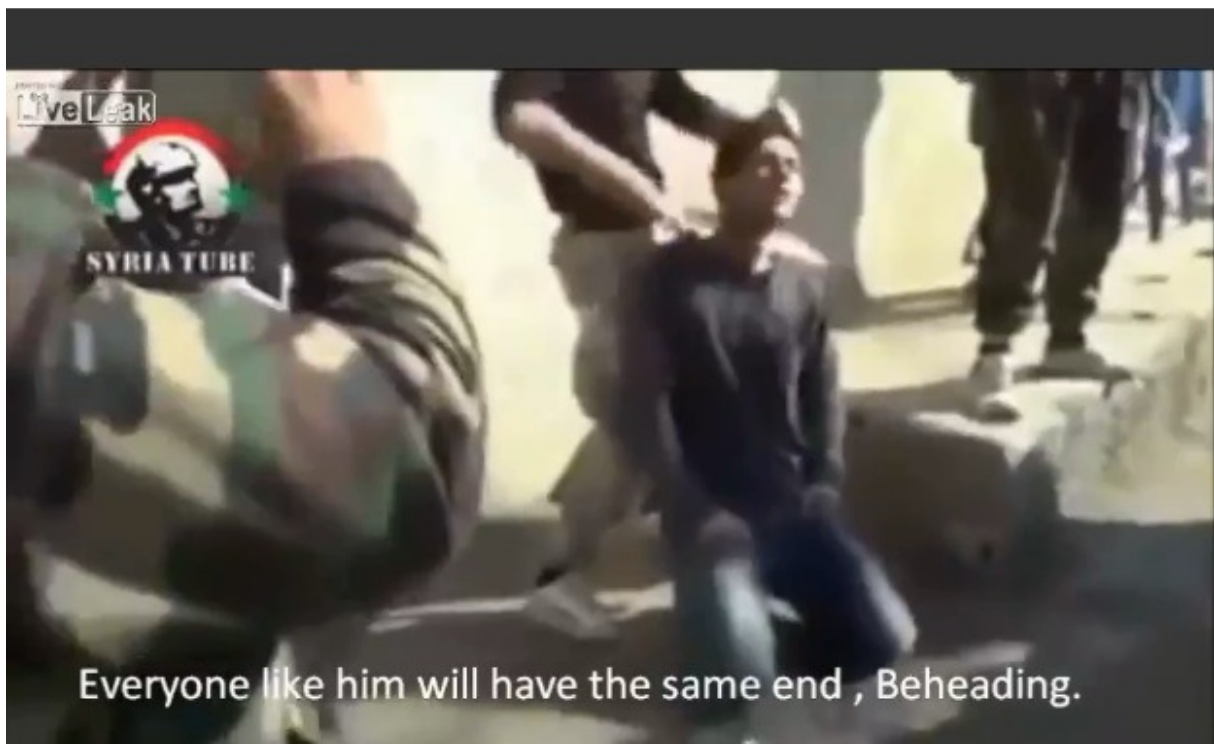

"Hayya alal Falah" (Rush to success) ~ repeated twice

"Allahu Akbar" (Allah is the Greatest) ~ repeated twice

"La ilaha illallah" (There is no god but Allah) ~ recited once

Never repeat these lines. Do what Theodore Shoebat says: Recite the

On earth, as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread,
